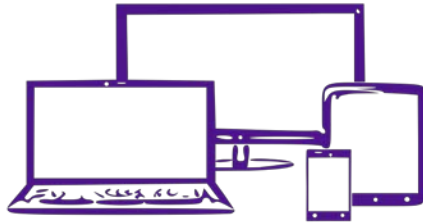


On-line Scholarship Application Now Open!



Applications are due on or before **February 15th**.

You must be nominated for this scholarship. If interested, see your guidance counselor for more details on how to apply.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS COVER THE FOLLOWING EXPENSES AND COULD BE VALUED UP TO \$7,000* PER STUDENT

- Application
- Tuition
- Miscellaneous Fees
- Books
- Testing (paid only once)
- Parking
- Licensure, as applicable
- Insurance, as applicable

*Scholarship value depends on the Orange Technical College program in which the student enrolls.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Student must have valid plans to pursue an education at Orange Technical College
- Student must be a graduating senior from an Orange County Public Schools high school with a cumulative GPA of **at least 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale**, a current Orange Technical College Student or an adult learner enrolling into an Orange Technical College program
- Student must have financial need **as evidenced by a Free/Reduced Lunch eligibility letter**.

HOW DO I APPLY?

To access the application, follow these steps:

- Go to [MyScholarship](#)
- Click "Create New Account" and follow the instructions
- Once logged in, type "**GOODP**" in the box labeled "Access Code" to the right
- "Click Enter Code"
- Click the blue APPLY button
- Complete all required fields and click on "Submit Application" when done

Note: You may "Save Application" in order to go back to your application at a later time after starting it.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- **Students** are nominated by a school faculty or staff member and receive a link to the on-line application from the nominator along with an access code to gain access to the application.
- As part of the application, students will enter the nominator's e-mail address in the on-line tool. The **nominator** will receive two e-mails: one from the student and one from the Central Florida Foundation with instructions on how to complete the on-line nomination form.
- All eligible applications will be reviewed and considered by a Central Florida Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.
- Finalists will be invited to an in-person panel interview to discuss their educational and career goals.
- The Scholarship Selection Committee will make their scholarship decisions immediately following the interviews and the Scholarship Recipients announced during each school's Senior Awards Ceremony.

FUND HISTORY

The Paul and Sarah Goodman Scholarship Fund was established in 2000 with the proceeds from the estate of Paul and Sarah Goodman. Mrs. Goodman was an outstanding teacher of English in the Orlando schools and was past president of the Florida Education Association. Mr. Goodman also taught school.

Their intent was to help deserving students interested in the vocational trades. The annual distribution from the fund is to be used for scholarships for needy students attending technical schools, vocational schools or educational programs for adults through Orange County Public Schools.
