

Q: Who is eligible for this grant?

A: Public, private, or faith-based entities located in or serving Winter Park, FL.

Q: What will this grant be able to fund?

A: Our primary focus this year is economic stability and equity. We're most interested in your ideas for unique projects that can increase the capability of your nonprofit or its programs to increase economic stability for your constituents and/or increase equity. Requests can include but are not limited to technology, program materials, staff training, and community collaboration. This time around, less weight will be given to proposals for marketing or strategic plans or staff positions. The grant does not need to cover the full cost of the project.

Q: How many grants will be awarded?

A: The Winter Park Community Grants seeks to award three one-time capabilities building and/or programmatic grants.

Three grants will be awarded this year:

- (1) grant for \$25,000
- (1) grant for \$15,000
- (1) grant for \$10,000

Q: Where can I find the grant application?

Q: How much time will I have to complete the grant application?

A: Applications close at **11:59 pm on September 30, 2022**. Existing Nonprofit Search profiles must be submitted for review by **September 23, 2022**. If you are a first-time applicant to a CFF grant, you must [create a Nonprofit Search Profile](#) and have it reviewed and updated by **September 23, 2022**

Q: How can be sure that my Nonprofit Search profile has been reviewed?

A: You can login to your [Nonprofit Search Profile](#). Check your profile's expiration date and update accordingly. For help with updating your profile, check out our [Annual Profile Update Checklist](#). When your profile has been reviewed, you should receive an automated email. If you're unsure if your profile has been reviewed, please email amahadeo@cffound.org.

Q: How will the grants be awarded?

A: After the submission deadline, a team of diverse community members will be charged with evaluating applications. This process can take about a month or longer
