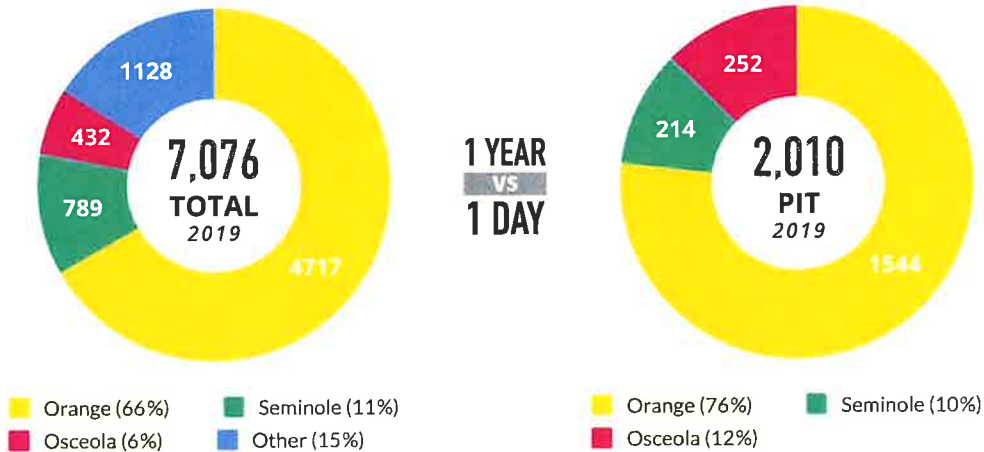




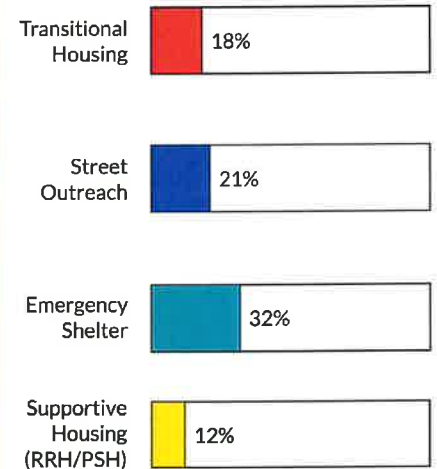

Annual Count of Homeless Persons vs Point in Time (PIT) Count of Homeless Persons with County Data



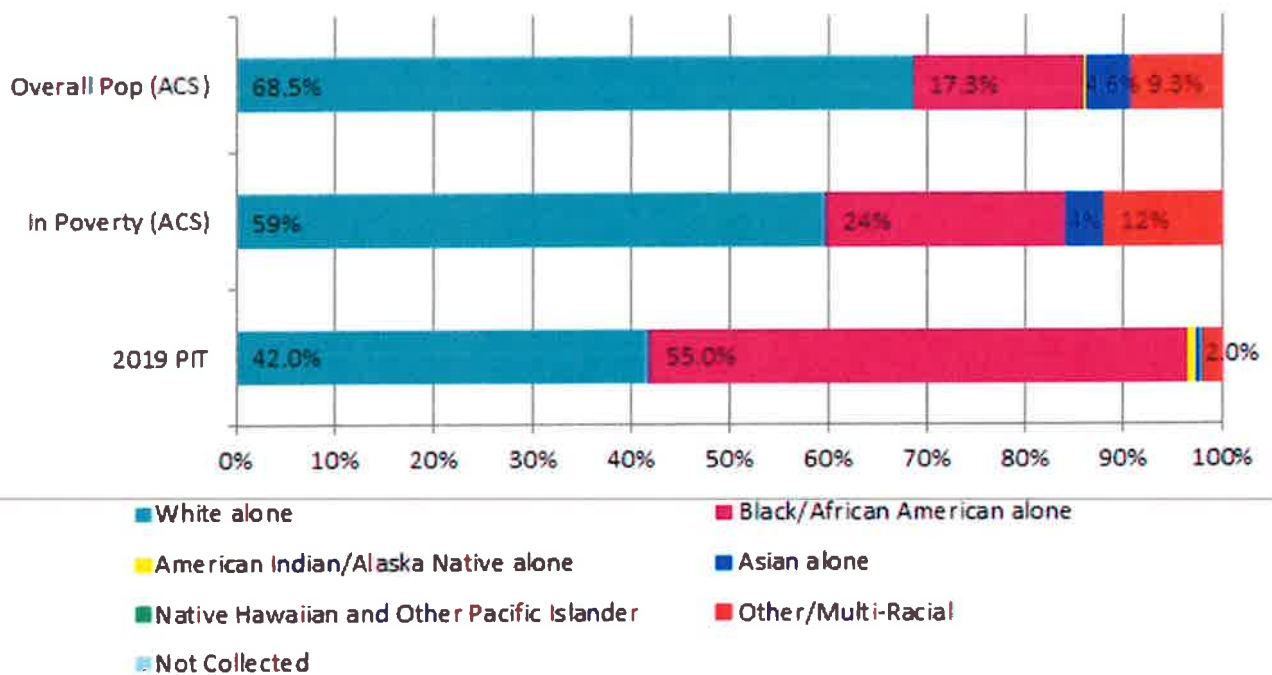
RETURNS TO HOMELESSNESS

2,650 were served in supportive housing.

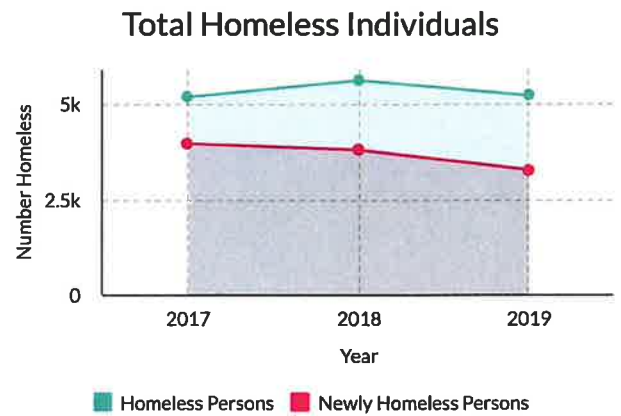
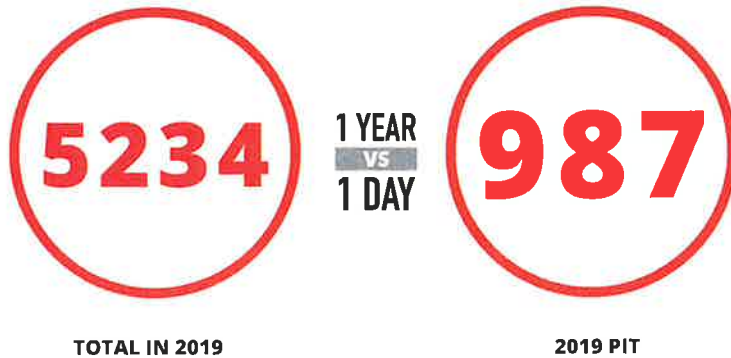
RACIAL DISPARITIES IN FL-507

22% Exit from homeless projects into Permanent Housing

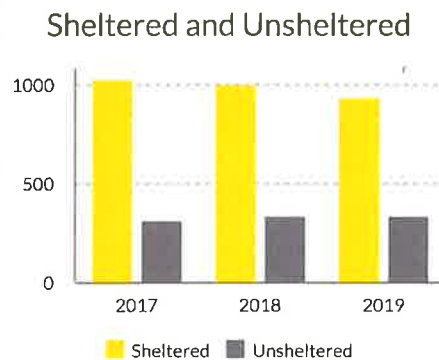

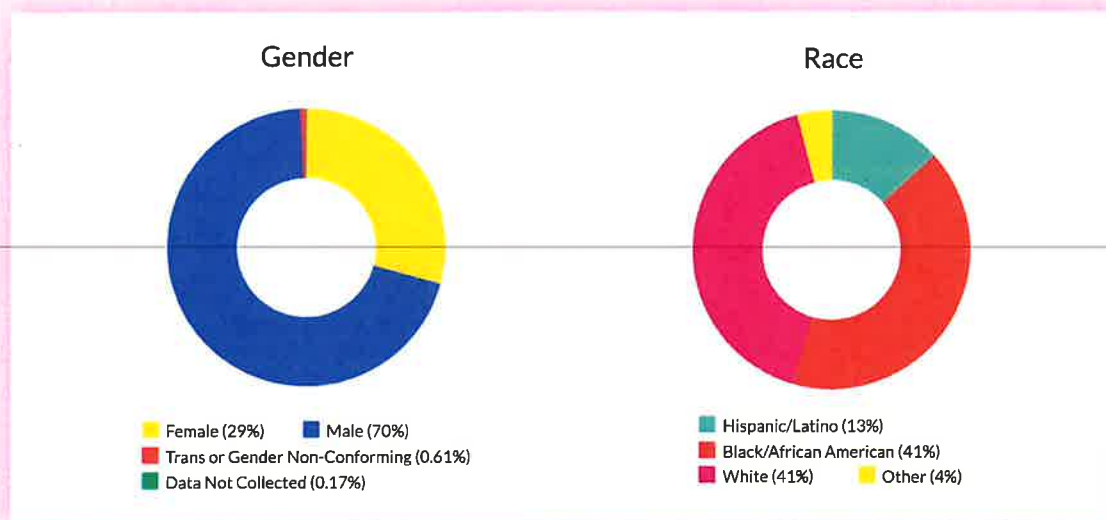

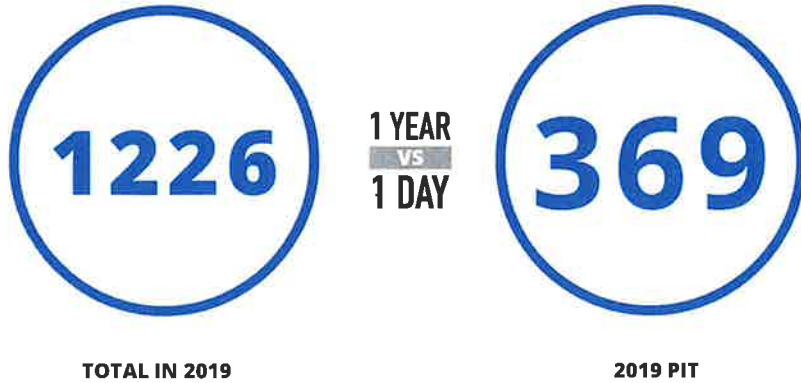


DEMOGRAPHICS ON HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS

CURRENT CHRONICALLY HOMELESS POPULATION

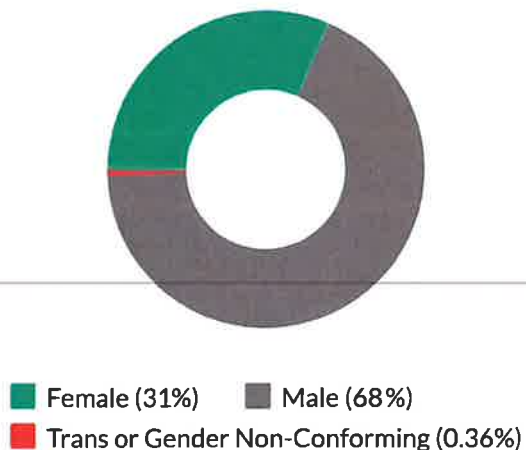
