To make a donation of stocks and/or bonds, please follow the instructions below.

- 1. Complete a Stock Transmittal Form (next page)
- 2. Submit a copy to your broker, and
- 3. Email a copy to Neil Rios Laverde at nrios@cffound.org.

If you have stocks in certificate form please contact the Foundation for detailed instructions and guidance. Gifts of mutual funds should refer to the Gifts of Mutual Funds document found on our website HERE.

Please note that for tax purposes, the date of your gift will be the date the stock is titled in Central Florida Foundation's name or is transferred to the Foundation's account.
