# A Community Roadmap for Transformational Change

#### Overview

The Creating a Healthy and Thriving Community initiative is a bold, systems-level effort to build a more vibrant and resilient Central Florida, starting in Orange County. Anchored by the Central Florida Foundation and guided by the Thrive Framework, this project seeks to bring together cross-sector leaders, residents, and organizations in a long-term, community-designed process for driving meaningful change.

At its core, the project focuses on the essential conditions that every individual and family needs to thrive: stable income, housing, nutrition, healthcare, education, safety, belonging, access to technology, and a healthy environment. It proposes a shift away from fragmented "sick care" systems and toward a **Salutogenic** model that fosters well-being from the ground up—through relationships, place-based assets, and inclusive participation.

This roadmap is more than a vision—it is a call to action.

## **Why This Matters**

Despite our collective progress, Central Florida continues to face persistent disparities across health, education, income, and opportunity. These challenges are interconnected, and so must be our solutions.

This initiative acknowledges:

- That real community change requires shared stewardship, not just isolated programs.
- That lived experience, cultural wisdom, and academic expertise must be brought together in new ways.
- That a "culture of health" is created, not given, through intentional design and collaboration.

The Thrive Framework helps guide this process with five interconnected areas:

- 1. Health and Well-being
- 2. Education
- 3. Economic Stability

- 4. Community and Social Connection
- 5. Livability (environment, safety, arts, and culture)

#### **How the Roadmap Works**

The roadmap serves as both a strategic framework and a practical guide for action. It includes:

- Data and Research: Evidence-based insights and real-time feedback loops.
- **Community Voice**: Facilitated sessions and storytelling from those with lived experience.
- **Blueprints for Action**: Each Thrive area will have its own set of goals, strategies, and metrics.
- Cross-Sector Leadership: A formal steering committee and five dedicated workgroups made up of subject-matter experts and community representatives.
- A Shared Destination: A region where everyone has a fair chance to lead a healthy and meaningful life.

Visual tools like road signs, mile markers, and detour options will help groups understand their starting points, chart progress, and stay aligned with the broader vision.

## **Get Involved: Be Part of the Change**

You can play a vital role in shaping the future of Central Florida. Here's how:

- **Lend Your Voice**: Join a workgroup or subgroup aligned with your area of expertise or interest.
