


Impactful giving for the causes you care about

- Closely Held Business Interests

Key Information

- \$25,000 initial gift minimum
- Multiple assets and complex gifts accepted
- Fund name, description, area of interest is completely customizable
- A geographic area of impact can be designated, such as a city or county

Fund Features



These funds are endowed, meaning only an annual amount under the current spending policy is granted, allowing it to last for generations.



You can continue to make contributions to the fund, receiving an immediate tax deduction each time. Transfer assets to fund after life to receive estate tax deduction.
