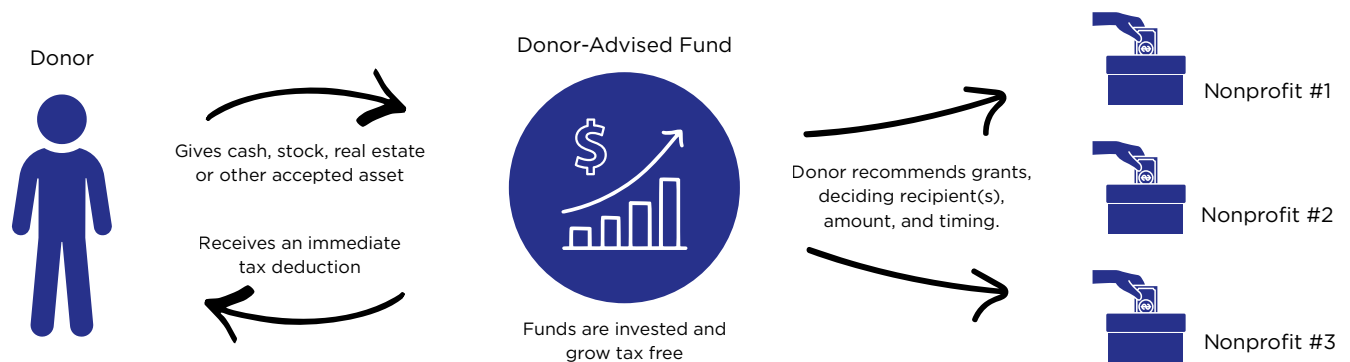


Flexible, streamlined charitable giving fund

- \$25,000 initial gift; no minimum after
- Complex assets accepted
- Donor maintains advisory privileges
- Donor selects an investment pool for fund
- Fund name and description is completely customizable
